What is this?

This scholarship is for students pursuing higher education who are interested in puzzles: solving puzzles, writing puzzles, and helping the puzzler community grow! The amount of this scholarship is \$2000.

How do I apply?

- 1. Confirm that you fulfill the eligibility requirements listed below.
- 2. Fill out the attached form (pgs. 3-4).
- 3. Write a puzzle and solution walkthrough, according to the guidelines.
- 4. Send us an email at <u>scholarship@missionstreetpuzzles.com</u>, with the completed form, puzzle, and solution write-up as attachments.

The due date is **Monday, May 18th, 2020** at 11:59pm PT. Winners will be announced in June.

Am I eligible?

You are eligible to apply for this scholarship if:

- You will be enrolled in an accredited four-year college or university in the U.S. or Canada for the 2020-2021 school year.
- You do not personally know any of the scholarship committee members.

What are the puzzle guidelines?

- The answer to the puzzle should be a point of interest (restaurant, park, etc.) anywhere in the world that is meaningful to you
- The answer location should be a definitive word or series of words (i.e. not a GPS coordinate).
- The puzzle should be in the freestyle "puzzle hunt" genre. Try browsing some of the examples at https://missionstreetpuzzles.com/puzzle-archives/.
- If your puzzle has any interactive elements, they should not require the solver to download any special software beyond a standard web browser. Feel free to include web links in your puzzle document.

- The puzzle writeup and solution walkthrough should be in separate documents.
- The puzzle should be entirely your own creative work--no copying content from other puzzle authors, even with their permission.
- You agree to allow us (Mission Street Puzzles) to share your puzzle at our discretion. Of course, you still maintain creative rights to your work.

What are the criteria for awarding this scholarship?

The winner will be chosen according to the following criteria:

- 40% Creativity and quality of puzzle
- 30% Presentation of puzzle
- 20% Narrative cohesiveness of puzzle
- 10% Compelling explanation for why the answer location is meaningful
