## Solution Walkthrough

The puzzle starts off with a poem in the top left. The first letter of each line spells out "CLIFFS."


The poem is referring to the ridge on the south side of the island labeled Silver Cliffs. Hidden in the cliffs are the letters XVII and XXVIII which are Roman Numerals for 17 and 28.


Follow these coordinates going over 17 and down 28 using the guide along the border to this volcano.


HIdden in the volcano is the word ISLAND


Travel southwest of the mainland to the island to find the next code. Match the symbols on the island to the arrows on the compass rose. In order from left to right starting with the top row it reads Northeast, West, Northeast, South, and South. When we abbreviate these words as shown on the compass rose we get NE W NE S S. Put these together to spell "newness"


We are finally at the last step! The last hidden message is encrypted in morse code along the shoreline of Newness Beach. The key at the top has groups of dots and dashes. Each group of symbols is assigned a letter of the alphabet in order from A to Z . For example the first wave is "-
$\bullet \bullet$ ". On the key that is the 4th group over so it is the fourth letter of the alphabet, D.


After translating the code we get our final answer, "Diagon Alley"
